- A. The first method of building a portfolio from *The Value Line Climate Change Investing Service* is to focus only on the newest recommendations. These stocks can be found by utilizing the "Inception Date" in the portfolio table. Subscribers simply purchase one or more of the most recent entries in the portfolio and, going forward, consider taking a position in all new stock purchases.
- B. Another method, which requires a more-activetrading strategy, is to purchase all (or almost all) stocks in the portfolio that are currently assigned a "Buy" rating.

In either case, before making any trades, subscribers are strongly encouraged to read our current and recent monthly reports for detailed information on specific equities. Subscribers also need to keep track of their holdings and review our updated ratings each month to ensure that we are not recommending any sells (and related buys).
